

How to Change the Notifications Tone Step-by-Step Instructions

This step-by-step guide walks mobile phone users through changing the notifications sound when a notification comes in. By completing these steps, when a notification comes—such as a Villages Emergency Alert—you will know it by the tone you gave it.

Step 1: Going to your mobile phone settings to access sound settings

Go to your mobile phone settings and tap the **Settings** icon which takes you to your settings menu. Go to **Sounds & Haptics** and tap the arrow.

Step 2: Choosing a Classic sound for your notifications

Once you tap the **Sounds & Haptics** arrow, you come to the **Sounds** settings. Go to **Default Alerts** and tap the arrow which takes you to all your sound choices. As a standard, we suggest that you select the **Classic** category. Click the arrow to go to **Classic** sound choices.

Step 3: Choosing Update as your notification tone

Once in the **Classic** sound selections, scroll to the bottom of the list and you see **Update**. Again, as a standard, we suggest you choose **Update** as your alert notifications tone.
